**NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CHANGE RATES**  
UNION PUBLIC SERVICE DISTRICT  
CASE NO. 22-0618-PSD-19A

On July 7, 2022, the Union Public Service District filed a Rule 19A application to adjust its sewer service rates and charges.

The Staff of the Public Service Commission has reviewed the application and has recommended the stipulated rates and charges. Stipulated rates are designed to produce \$371,179 annually, or 13.37%, over current rates. The current rates and stipulated rates are as follows:

The stipulated rates and charges are calculated to increase the average sewer bill for residential customers using 3,400 gallons of water monthly by \$4.79. The Stipulated rates and charges are calculated to increase the average sewer bill for commercial customers using 19,400 gallons of water monthly by \$23.47. The Stipulated rates and charges are calculated to increase the average sewer bill for industrial customers using 15,800 gallons of water monthly by \$20.24. The Stipulated rates and charges are calculated to increase the average sewer bill for public authority customers using 74,200

gallons of water monthly by \$74.56. The Stipulated rates and charges are calculated to increase the average sewer bill for bulk rate customers using 51,100 gallons of water monthly by \$57.23.

Anyone desiring to review the Staff recommendation reports may do so on the Commission website ([www.psc.state.wv.us](http://www.psc.state.wv.us)). Anyone desiring to protest the changed rates and charges must do so, in writing, within ten (10) days of the date of publication of this notice. All protests may be filed online through the Commission website using the "Submit a Comment" link or may be mailed to the Executive Secretary, Public Service Commission of West Virginia, P. O. Box 812, Charleston, West Virginia 25323, or hand-delivered to the Public Service Commission. To help the Commission determine the justification for additional review and investigation, protests must be specific as to reasons that the changed rates and charges should be modified.

The Commission may adopt rates and charges which are the same as, greater than or less than the Staff-recommended rates and charges.
